

Connexions C3 & C4 Bus Service Isleham – Newmarket – Ely

Did you know that residents of Isleham have a bus service to Newmarket and Ely on a Saturday?

Parishioners have the choice to travel to Ely or Newmarket on a unique service organised by Isleham Parish Council in conjunction with Cambridgeshire County Council.

These services, the 'C3' (Isleham - Chippenham - Snailwell – Newmarket) and the 'C4' (Snailwell - Chippenham - Isleham - Prickwillow - Queen Adelaide - Ely) aim to offer choice to passengers wanting a few hours to shop in Ely or Newmarket. The C3 also offers two return trips, so that passengers can change in Newmarket to spend a few hours in Cambridge or Bury St Edmunds instead!

The C3 and C4 services are part of the "Cambridgeshire Connexions" network of services set up by Cambridgeshire County Council, whereby each community served by these services can play a part in its existence and operation, mostly by selling tickets to parishioners wishing to use, in effect, the parish run bus.

To use the C3 and C4 services, you need to buy a ticket in advance from the following outlets (you cannot buy tickets on the bus):

- The Post Office, Sun Lane, Isleham
- The Paper Shop, Mill Street, Isleham
- The Tharp Arms Public House, Chippenham
- Hiam Sports and Social Club, Putney Hill Road, Prickwillow, open every Evening 7pm-11pm, Thurs 1pm-4.30pm & Sun 12noon-3pm
- Prickwillow Drainage Engine Museum, Main Street, Prickwillow, open Mon Tue Fri Sat Sun 11am-4.30pm (May-Sep), Sat Sun 1pm-4pm (Apr & Oct), closed Nov-Mar.

Tickets cost between £1.50 and £2.50 return to either Ely or Newmarket depending on where you intend to board the bus.
